Dear President-elect Obama and Congressional Leaders,

Thank you for your steadfast commitment to engaging all Americans in strengthening our country. We believe that service and the nonprofit sector have a vital role to play in the nation's short- and long-term economic recovery and urge you to make significant strategic investments in these two areas as part of the economic stimulus package.

President Roosevelt recognized the power of service to provide both hope and opportunity to ordinary Americans when he created the Civilian Conservation Corps in 1933. Within four months of his inauguration, 275,000 young men from all walks of life were providing vital environmental service—and earning a living wage in the process. It was the most popular of the New Deal programs. Today, as in 1933, our nation needs an “all hands on deck” strategy that mobilizes Americans to help the families and communities most affected by the economic recession, to invest in the nation's human capital, and to increase our competitiveness.

The non-profit sector represents 9.7% of all jobs in the U.S. economy. In the short-term this sector, like other sectors, is threatened by debilitating job losses due to shrinking revenue. At the same time, nonprofit organizations are experiencing an unprecedented increase in applications for service opportunities and for the essential services that these organizations provide. A targeted investment in national and community service and a non-profit stimulus package to match new investments from philanthropy would create hundreds of thousands of low-cost jobs. An investment in the nonprofit sector and a significant expansion of service would:

- Match government investment with significant contributions from private philanthropy, local government, and civil society to solve problems;
- Focus on results, accountability, and transparency to maximize and extend public investments;
- Mobilize Americans to serve through full-time national service positions as well as millions of well-structured opportunities to volunteer locally, meeting human needs, building human capital, and strengthening our civic infrastructure at a critical time.

Some groundwork has already been laid for these ideas, including President-elect Obama's bold plan for service and social innovation, and the bi-partisan Serve America Act. These and other ideas, such as a stimulus fund and bridge loans for the nonprofit sector, can form the basis of a powerful non-profit stimulus package that saves or generates jobs in the short-run and efficiently builds human capital over time.

Adding the proposals from President-elect Obama's national service plan, including an expansion of AmeriCorps, and the Serve America Act to the stimulus package would create more than 125,000 new full- and part-time jobs by the summer of 2009, and an additional

50,000 new jobs the following year. When combined with the current AmeriCorps levels, this would place 250,000 citizens in national service in the year 2010. This investment in national service will also provide a critical, low-cost workforce for the nonprofit sector during challenging economic times, while leveraging hundreds of millions of dollars in private matching funds. A nonprofit stimulus fund, patterned after the network of social innovation funds that President-elect Obama called for during the campaign, could help stabilize and grow effective nonprofit organizations that provide vital services in the areas of education, youth development, poverty alleviation, the environment and more. We also hope that you will encourage state and local governments to engage service organizations and nonprofit groups in key roles as part of their stimulus plans.

Thank you for your vision and leadership for America, and for your strong support for service and the nonprofit sector. We stand ready to serve with you, and to follow your lead as we look collectively to strengthen our country.
